

Moore Spice and Alisan restaurants make it to Wembley in grand style

THE Aroma Group of restaurants has announced the addition of 'Alisan', a flagship establishment which recently opened in Engineers Way, Wembley, alongside Moore Spice 1966.

These two stylish restaurants occupy a fantastic location right opposite the famous Wembley 'arc' and would make the ideal venue for your Christmas party.

Offering dim sum and fine Chinese cuisine, Alisan launched with a grand opening on Saturday complete with fire crackers and traditional Lion dance, which according to leg-

The word "san" means mountain or hill in Chinese. The letters "LIS" in the ALISAN logo form the Chinese character for mountain.

Dim sum head chef, CC Wong, was dim sum head chef at Yauatcha Michelin-starred Soho restaurant.

Dim sum is served noon until 5pm. The restaurant head chef, GW Dai, was previously at the Mandarin Oriental, a five-star hotel, in Singapore.

The split-level establishment seats up to 200 on the ground floor. The first floor features a cocktail lounge, with sofa seating, serving drinks and snacks.

A function room is available for private hire, complete with karaoke facilities.

The décor of Alisan creates a modern yet Oriental setting combining an Eastern feel with modern European features.

Commenting on the new opening, Aroma director Colin Wong said: "The area deserves a first-rate modern Chinese restaurant offering fine dining and good dim sum".

Moore Spice 1966 boasts the finest, authentic Indian cuisine and a wonderful light and airy contemporary interior.

There is a stunning refurbished bar, downstairs dining zone with stained glass windows and upstairs with a red-and-white themed seating in honour of Bobby Moore and England's 1966 world cup victory - after which the restaurant is named.
